New Business:

Bethel – Covid Screening may be required more than we had suggested in “Return to Mat guidelines” We need to prepare for that. Steve Losee shared the idea of using a contract tracing “check-in” style app to aggregate all the data on participants to one place.

Update from WSWA – No new changes from Justin except to be ready. WSWA schedule is out and will be wrestled if it can be.

All clubs were reminded to renew their charter and have athletes, coaches and volunteers renew their memberships to maintain the liability and secondary medical insurance.

Reiterated by Auburn that if charters and memberships are renewed, protection is in place for "At-Home" organized workouts that follow the health department guidelines.

Reopened tabled discussion about allowing 13/14 year olds into league this season. It was discussed that it might make sense to have a "Middle school" Division for those kids. Yelm suggested that it may not be a good idea because we are trying to limit number of people in the building and this may be detrimental to our efforts. Darrel suggested that we keep this tabled until we have a better idea of the "plan." - Age discussion will remain tabled.
